Issue

This notice concerns an issue found in RayCare 5B and 6A including service packs. Values will not be visible for documents in a read-only state when opened outside the Documents workspace when using document fields configured with single- or multi-selectable values.

To the best of our knowledge, the issue has not caused any patient mistreatment or other incidents. However, the user must be aware of the following information to avoid the described issue.

Intended audience

This notice is directed to all users of RayCare 5B and 6A including service packs who use the RayCare configurable documents and RayCare domain objects.

Product Name and Version

The products affected by this notice are sold under the trade names RayCare 5B and 6A including service packs. To determine if the version you are using is affected, open the About RayCare dialog in the RayCare application and check if the build number reported there is "5.1.1.60246", "5.1.3.60023" or "6.0.0.60553". If so, this notice applies to your version.

Description

RayCare supports user configurable documents that can contain data from RayCare in predefined RayCare domain objects (RDO). The RDOs can have different types where the object has a single value or multiple values (list value). During the configuration of a list RDO, the user can select to display all values, select a single value or select multiple values. When a document is created for a patient based on a document template with one or more list RDO(s) where selection is possible and the document is not in a draft state, the selected values for the list RDOs will not be visible. In RayCare 5B, the issue occurs when the document



is opened outside of the Documents workspace. In RayCare 6A the issue occurs when the document is opened from a task in the Activities workspace. When the document is opened from other workspaces, the selected items will be displayed correctly.

Actions to be taken by the user

- Educate staff and all users to open configurable documents from the Documents workspace to avoid the issue.
- Review all configured documents and consider reconfiguration in a way that will not trigger the issue.
- Inspect your product and identify all installed units with the above software version number(s).
- Confirm you have read and understood this notice by replying to the notification email.

Solution

This issue will be resolved in the next version of RayCare, scheduled for market release in December 2023 (RayCare 2024A), (subject to market clearance in some markets) and future versions. If customers wish to continue using RayCare, they must upgrade to the new version once it becomes available for clinical use.
